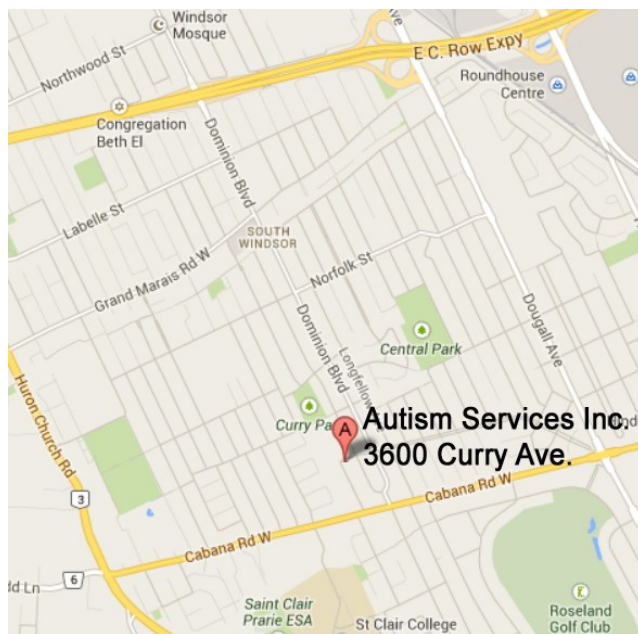

Resource Lending Library

We maintain a lending library of over 900 books, DVDs, software, books on CD, educational toys and other teaching resources on the topic of Autism Spectrum Disorders.

There are no borrowing fees or memberships required.

Library visitors are welcome to use the specialized computer software such as Boardmaker to create choice boards and picture communication schedules.

Teachers can access the library through the inter school courier system.

Bruce Awad Summer Program

We provide a multi week program in July and August for children and youth ages 6 to 21 years with a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorders. The program runs Monday to Friday and is highly structured with emphasis on communication, socialization, behaviour management, daily living skills, recreation and community activities. A one-to-one or two-to-one student to support worker ratio is maintained for a safe environment. Staff are highly trained and experienced. The program is offered at Windsor and Essex locations.



Community Partnerships

We work with other local agencies to assist families to find the information and support they need.

The Autism Registry

The Autism Registry is a Windsor Police Services project in partnership with Autism Services Inc. that gives police quick access to information about a registered person with ASD. The online Registry is available to residents of Windsor at www.police.windsor.on.ca.
