

POLICE CLEARANCES

All employees of the Bruce Awad Summer Program are required to obtain a ***Vulnerable Sector Check*** through their local police department.

Vulnerable Sector Check

This search is restricted to applicants seeking employment and/or volunteering with vulnerable persons or children.

Who are vulnerable persons?

Vulnerable persons or individuals refer to persons who, because of their age, a disability or other circumstances, whether temporary or permanent are in a position of dependence on others or are otherwise at greater risk than the general population of being harmed by persons in a position of authority or trust relative to them, for an example: children, disabled or elderly.

VALID IDENTIFICATION

In order for the police to release or confirm confidential information regarding a person's criminal record, or lack thereof, the police require sufficient proper identification to verify a person's identity. This identification must be presented in person to be physically verified by the local detachment.

For the purposes of a criminal records check, a police records check or a vulnerable sector check, we require the following identification.

Each applicant must provide two (2) pieces of valid, government issued identification. One (1) piece of identification must include a photo, name, date of birth and signature.

Please note that **HEALTH CARDS & SOCIAL INSURANCE CARDS ARE NOT ACCECEPTED.**

Before going to your local police department you must contact our office 519-966-7283 to obtain a "Consent to Disclosure of Personal Information" and an "Agency Letter".

IF YOU ARE A RESIDENT OF THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

Lakeshore, Tecumseh, Essex, Kingsville, Harrow: Police clearances must be completed by your local Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) department.

LaSalle, Amherstburg, Leamington: Please pick up your police clearance forms from your area's local police department.

Windsor: Please pick up your police clearance forms from the police department

Outside of Essex County: Please go to your local police department to have your police clearance completed.
